The Poems and Verses of Charles Dickens Charles Dickens, 2012-04-09

When we consider Dickens's life and work in comparison with that of the two great poets we have been studying the contrast is startling. While Tennyson and Browning were being educated for the life of literature and shielded most tenderly from the hardships of the world, Dickens a poor, obscure and suffering child was helping to support a shiftless family by pasting labels on blacking bottles, sleeping under a counter like a homeless cat and once a week timidly approaching the big prison where his father was confined for debt. In 1836 his *Pickwick* was published and life was changed as if a magician had waved his wand over him. While the two great poets were slowly struggling for recognition, Dickens with plenty of money and too much fame was the acknowledged literary hero of England, the idol of immense audiences which gathered to applaud him wherever he appeared. And there is also this striking contrast between the novelist and the poets that while the whole tendency of the age was toward realism away from the extremes of the romanticists and from the oddities and absurdities of the early novel writers, it was precisely by emphasizing oddities and absurdities by making caricatures rather than characters that Dickens first achieved his popularity.

Charles Dickens, the Writer and His Work Barbara Hardy, 1983

The *Writers and their Work* series contains three essays on Dickens: an account of biographical and critical studies by K. J. Fielding and appreciations of the early and the late novels by Trevor Blount and Barbara Hardy respectively. Professor Hardy's present essay, the third in the series, combines a biographical introduction with a complete survey of the novels, sketches and other prose works. Dickens originally learned his craft as a journalist and the essay begins with a chapter on his first descriptions of London. *Sketches by Boz* traces the process whereby his observation of city life and social change gradually developed into an elaborate fictional technique. Of the early novels *Oliver Twist* and *Nicholas Nickleby* are the most fully discussed, with especial attention to Dickens's insight into criminal psychology in the former. In the later novels, beginning with *Bleak House*, Hardy finds a closer unity of theme and structure, the result of the firmer grasp of social criticism which Dickens displays during the 1850s and 1860s. There had been plenty of exposure of contemporary injustices and abuses in the earlier fiction, but in the later the confrontation between rich and poor has become more urgent, the comedy less carefree, the comic and serious elements more closely blended. In these later novels too, Hardy notes an effort to bring the imagination more closely to bear upon the inner life of the principal characters. Dickens does not attempt the kind of novel which is shaped by inner action as George Eliot and Henry James were to do; he keeps an external focus on society but strives within this dimension for a fuller access to the inward conflicts of characters such as Edith in *Dombey and Son* and Pip in *Great Expectations*.
